SHUTDOWN OF GENERATING STATION ST. MARYS RIVER

1. A shutdown will occur of the Great Lakes Power Limited's Sault Ste. Marie, Ontario Clergue Generating Station on Saturday, 30 August 2003 for eight (8) hours from around 0600 hours to around 1400 hours for the inspection of 115 kv cables.
2. This will result in a reduction of the originally expected St. Marys River flow during this period to those as shown below:

Estimated St. Marys River flows on Saturday 30 August 2003 are expected to be:

From 0000 hrs to 0600 hours: 2,010 cms (71,000 cfs)

From 0600 hrs to 1400 hours: Reduced from about 2,010 cms (71,000 cfs) to about 1,063 cms (37,500 cfs), Great Lakes Power Ltd's Clergue Station is off line.

From 1400 hrs to 2400 hrs: Return to a flow of about 2,010 cms (71,000 cfs)

3. Check with the U.S. Coast Guard "Soo Traffic" for additional information.
4. Mariners are urged to use extreme caution in the area.
